SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS 2019

Skippers Hill Academic Scholarships are awarded annually and are available to external applicants currently in National Curriculum Years 2 to Year 8, and to internal applicants in Year 2 and Year 6. Scholarship Examination assessments are conducted whilst spending a day at Skippers and are awarded at the discretion of the headmaster to children who are demonstrably in the upper 10% of the ability range nationally.

Academic Scholarships are based on academic achievement and are assessed against Nationally Standardised Tests. Supplementary testing and data may be used, such as phonic screening, reading comprehension, reading accuracy and picture reasoning. Current attainment in English and maths is assessed using online Progress Tests. Previous school reports will be considered where available and ongoing teacher assessment against current class cohort during taster day. For older children, online CAT tests in verbal, quantitative, spatial and non-verbal reasoning are used. Reading and Spelling age tests may also be administered. For internal candidates, assessment data from within the school is used for initial screening, followed by the same Nationally Standardised tests.

All Awards will be tenable from the date of entry for the duration of your child's time at Skippers, subject to continued attainment based upon ongoing assessment at the school.

A small number of Scholarships/Exhibitions are also available for Sport, Art, Drama and Music. Any outside testimonials will prove very helpful.

Total amount of any combined Scholarship Award will not exceed 40% for children in Key Stage 2. For entry into Year 7, the Academic, Sports and Performing Arts Scholarships can be raised to 50% at the discretion of the headmaster.

In cases of proven financial need, Awards may be augmented, subject to available funds and completion and submission of a Financial Questionnaire, with supporting evidence.
