Kindergarten Afternoon Activities

Monday - Art, Music and Movement

Children enjoy painting, collage work and modelling, with a focus on Kindergarten's seasonal topic. During this session, the children are also introduced to different types of dancing techniques - from ballet to street dance - and encouraged to have a go, with props to aid inspiration!

Tuesday - Swoove

The children enjoy a fun and active session of singing and movement, followed by a lovely lie down and some relaxation.

Wednesday - Malleable Materials

Malleable materials - such as playdough, clay and gloop - encourage children to use each of their five senses, as well as helping physical dexterity and the development of fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination. The children can explore a range of materials and develop their skills in using tools and manipulating the materials.

Thursday - Woodland Explorers

Utilising the school's 22-acres of land, Woodland Explorers takes learning outdoors and enables the children to throw themselves wholeheartedly into the explorations and activities which have been carefully planned each week. Activities range from den building and looking at animal homes, to using our very own 'mud kitchen' and spotting seasonal changes.

Friday - Construction & Block Work

The children create 2D and 3D models around a narrative devised by themselves. The benefits of working with well-designed blocks include: developing mathematical understanding of proportion and fractions; developing language skills through narrative; developing and encouraging creative ideas; and encouraging personal and social skills through collaboration.
