

Skippers Hill Scholarships are awarded annually and are available to external applicants currently in Years 2 to Year 8, and to internal applicants currently in Year 2 and Year 6. We intend to run our scholarships in the week beginning **8th of March**. If allowed in school at this time our Scholarship Examination Assessments will be conducted onsite, if not then the assessments will be online.

Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the Headmaster to children who are demonstrably in the upper 10% of the ability range nationally. All Awards will be tenable from the date of entry for the duration of your child's time at Skippers, subject to ongoing assessment at the school. Total amount of any combined Scholarship Award will not exceed 30%.

Academic – Nationally Standardised Testing will be primarily used with online CAT tests administered in verbal, quantitative, spatial and non-verbal reasoning. Supplementary assessments will be used and an interview with our Director of Studies.

Art – During an interview with our Head of Art applicants will be asked to perform a set number of tasks and show a portfolio of their recent artwork.

Dance – During an interview with our Dance Teacher applicants will be asked to perform an assigned routine, another of their choice and a variety of technique exercises. Prerecorded pieces can also be submitted as part of the process.

Drama – During an interview with our Head of Performing Arts applicants will be asked to perform a monologue/poem of their choice and undertake some directed improvisation tasks and script work. Pre-recorded pieces can also be submitted as part of the process.

Music – During an interview with our Head of Performing Arts applicants will be asked to perform two contrasting pieces of music of the applicants choice on their chosen instrument/instruments, and undertake some musical listening tests. Pre-recorded pieces can also be submitted as part of the process.

Sport – During an interview with our Head of Sport and Deputy Head applicants will be set a number of sporting challenges and given an opportunity to demonstrate a particular skill or expertise.

For children who have been awarded a scholarship, but for whom an education at Skippers would be inaccessible a bursary is available, subject to funds and completion of our bursary application form with supporting evidence. Bursaries are offered for an academic year at a time, after which the family is required to provide fresh information about their circumstances for every year that their child attends the school.
